Governor's message

Beyond service lies a hopeful future.

Having entered the month of December, we have already reached the halfway point of the 2021-22 year.

The Official Visit for Japan concluded on November 30, and we are conducting arrangements to make the one for the Pacific Basin Group (PBG) next spring. My goal is to make that visit in the 2021-22 year no matter the cost so that I can talk with the members of the PBG face to face.

For the "World Polio Day Train Jack Project" held in October, we received numerous emails from you accompanied by photos taken inside trains and words of praise. The walk rally held on the final day of the project included the participation of individuals who personally overcame polio. Together with the numerous Rotarians, Rotaractors, Interactors and citizens who also participated, these individuals called for an end to polio as they walked enjoyably from Tokyo Station to Yurakucho Station.

In the plaza in front of Yurakucho Station, an event requesting donations to end polio was held. Rotarians from other Districts participated in this event as well, making it a pleasurable experience. District Governors and numerous other Rotarians who had seen photos and videos of the event sent many emails commending us on our efforts. I would also like to greatly applaud and thank The District Public Image Committee Chair Yasushi Tanaka and the other members of the Committee for their hard work and capacity for action in the planning and execution of this event.

December is "Disease Prevention and Treatment

Month." While an end to polio has been declared in Africa, the same cannot be said of Asia, where two cases of polio, one in Pakistan and Afghanistan each, have been reported. It is the earnest wish of Rotary and of mankind at large that polio be eradicated. Once infected with polio, people retain considerable disabilities that they must live with for the rest of their lives. We must do everything in our power to keep increasing our efforts if we want to fully end the disease someday.

However, the reality is that the aforementioned regions are conflict zones where administering vaccines is accompanied with considerable danger, making such a task incredibly difficult. Even so, neither Rotary nor mankind can give up. I want us all to promise that we will continue this fight going forward as we keep in our hearts that the day when polio is fully eradicated will indeed come in the near future.

The struggle against various illnesses, COVID-19 included, continues throughout the world. Because of conflict and wealth disparity, it is difficult to secure "water, sanitation and hygiene" in these regions, leaving "disease prevention and treatment" unable to function effectively. The people paying the greatest price for that are untold numbers of children. Each of your clubs and each of you as Rotarians are now being called upon to think about what is within your power to do and to take action so that those children may have a life teeming with hope. Perhaps more than any other, our mission as Rotarians is to connect with the world with a spirit of service and carve out a hopeful future.
