It has been more than six months since the Russian invasion of Ukraine started. Actions that endanger human lives are totally unacceptable. Many people have been killed and communities have been destroyed. Basic education is essential for the children who are the future of the country. For this reason, early reconstruction is essential. Continuing the education of Ukrainian children will be the fundamental driver of the country's recovery. Rotary's seven areas of focus must be implemented there.

It is our mission as Rotarians to continue our efforts until the Ukrainian people restore peaceful days. Let's make the most of our global grants and invest in the future of our world. Last Rotary year we used the Rotary Foundation's Disaster Relief Fund to contribute a fire truck at the initiative of District 2630. This Rotary year, District 2750 is engaged in a project as the representative together with 16 districts, to contribute modular houses (prefabricated houses). The project is called Rotary Village (Rotary Town) and is now under construction. The Governor's official visit began on July 25. Under the ongoing Coronavirus situation, we are proceeding the visits in a flexible manner with the understanding and cooperation of club presidents and members. The role of the governor is to help building vibrant clubs. I meet members face-to-face, listen to their opinions and requests through conversations, and reflect them in the activities of our district committees. Let's not be defeated by Coronavirus, but exert the power of "Team Rotary" together with our members and do our best to contribute to society.
