June is Rotary Fellowships Month



Dear Rotarians and Rotaractors,

While the time has flown by with only one month left in this Rotary year, how are you doing? As governor I have been running through the year with all my might raising "It doesn' t matter if we don' t take action!" as our district slogan. The theme of my speech at the Governor's Official Visit was "If it's not fun, it's meaningless!" . I shared the policies of RI President Gordon R. McInerney, and especially in the roundtable discussion at each club with the president, secretary, and president-elect, I explained the "Vision Statement" and the "Action Plan" of RI, then conveyed the importance of creating each club's "Action Plan" in line with its "Vision Statement" and RI's "Four Priorities". At the International Assembly, RI President-elect Stephanie A. Urchick reminded everyone of the need for organizational changes and for us to change together. With that in mind, she called on everyone to be a promoter of the Action Plan to change our clubs for the better and maintain Rotary's strength. I am not a prophet. When I thought at the beginning of this year about what we would need to do to "Grow Rotary" and what I should tell you, I decided to talk about the Action Plan, based on the messages from RI presidents over the past few years. I then asked you to keep the two wheels of a bicycle turning, namely "Service and Fellowships". The Action plan is a useful tool to help make your club experience better.

In October and April, I ran two cycling challenges as a bike governor. In October, I rode about 300 kilometers from Kashiwazaki (Niigata) to Ariake(Tokyo), and in April, I rode about 560 kilometers from Osaka to Nihonbashi(Tokyo). The reason why I did what seemed so reckless was, of course, to eradicate polio, but I also wanted to bring back energy, courage, and smiles to the Rotarians and Rotaractors of District 2750. I felt that the clubs in Japan had been exhausted due to the impact of COVID-19 for three years. I wanted to convey a message to them by my challenges, "You can have your hope and be a person of your word."

There is still one month to go. How you spend this month will be the true test of the value of everyone in District 2750. Please do not give up. We must do all what we can do now to make "Create Hope in the World" a reality.

I would like to share with you the last Paul Harris quote of the year.

Now, at the close of this, my last year of activity in the National Association, and just before the drop of the curtain in the final scene of the last act, I shall give myself the honor of a moment's pause before the footlights while I make a low bow and with heartfelt sincerity tremblingly repeat the old stereotyped but soulful words; "Thanking you one and all, on the part of my little company, and myself, for your very kind attention, I bid you God speed, Fare ye Well!"
