I would like to take this opportunity to wish you all a very happy and refreshing New Year.

It has already been six months since we started our activities together with you this Rotary year. I was able to understand during my official visit that each club is engaged in meaningful activities under the enthusiasm and leadership of the president. Last December, the 53rd Rotary Institute was held in Yokohama, Japan. The RI president designates one or more conveners to organize each institute, and this year Past Governor Isao Mizuno of District 2750 was assigned as the convener. Many Rotary leaders including governors, past governors, governors-elect, governors-nominee, and assistant governors from RI Zones 1A, 2, and 3 participated in the Institute, which welcomed RI President Stephanie A. Urchick, President's Aide Thomas A. Gump and his wife, the Chair of the Trustees of The Rotary Foundation Mark Daniel Maloney and his wife, and the Vice Chair of the Trustees of The Rotary Foundation Larry A. Lunsford.

Prior to the institute, Urchick visited the Rotary Peace Center at International Christian University in our district. There, Urchick personally presented the charter of the newly established Rotaract Club of ICU, which was a great start.

At the institute, Urchick said, “All areas of focus lead to peace. Peace leads to all areas of focus”. Peace is at the



heart of everything we do. I reconfirmed my passion to continue to work with you this year, keeping in mind the ultimate purpose of Rotary and Urchick's top priority, namely “Peace Building”.
